1. Retirement Resignation

The Board, by a unanimous voice vote of the seven members present, approved a motion by Mrs. Glaneman, seconded by Mrs. Garry, to accept the resignation, for purposes of retirement, of Deborah Stablein, as an Aide at the Ringgold Elementary School South effective Thursday, June 28, 2018.

2. Employment Of Teachers

The Board, by a unanimous vote to the call of the roll of the seven members present, approved a motion by Mrs. Glaneman, seconded by Mrs. Garry, to employ the following teachers:

Hannah Castaneda as a Special Education/Elementary Teacher at Ringgold Elementary School North at a salary of \$37,500 – Step 1 – Bachelors Degree

3. Addition To The Substitute Roster

4. **Permission To Take Trip**

Where: Old Ringgold Middle School, Finleyville


Cost: No fees associated with this usage as the request occurs during normal operating hours and does not require the presence of additional custodial or security personnel.
